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Poster Guidelines

If your poster is selected, please follow the guidelines below when designing your poster.

Poster format

To ensure consistency and readability across the Forum poster exhibition, accepted posters should follow the guidelines below:

Poster size and layout

- Posters should be prepared in **portrait format**.
- Recommended poster size: **A0 (841 mm × 1189 mm)**.
- Posters should be clear, visually engaging and easy to read from a distance.

Digital poster file format

- The final digital poster should be submitted as a **high-resolution PDF file**.
- Please ensure the PDF is formatted to the final poster size (**A0 portrait: 841 mm × 1189 mm**) and is suitable for digital viewing and printing.
- File name format: **Surname_FirstName_PosterTitle.pdf**

Recommended poster structure

Posters should include:

Title	• Clear and concise title reflecting the project or initiative.
Background/challenge	• Brief description of the problem, opportunity or unmet need being addressed.
Approach/implementation	• Description of the intervention, innovation or approach taken.
Impact/outcomes	• Highlight results, improvements, key findings or evidence of impact.

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Key learning	• Share one practical insight or recommendation that others can apply.
Contact	• Please include contact details for one author in case attendees wish to connect or request further information after the Forum.

Design recommendations

- Prioritise visuals over large blocks of text.
- Use charts, diagrams, images or other visual elements where appropriate.
- Ensure text is large enough to be read easily.
- Use clear fonts and maintain good contrast between text and background.
- Focus on key messages, outcomes and impact.

A select group of poster presenters will be invited to participate in a **7-minute poster presentation session** during the Forum. Additional information regarding poster presentations will be provided to selected presenters in due course.

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
